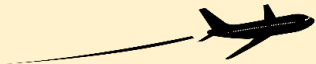

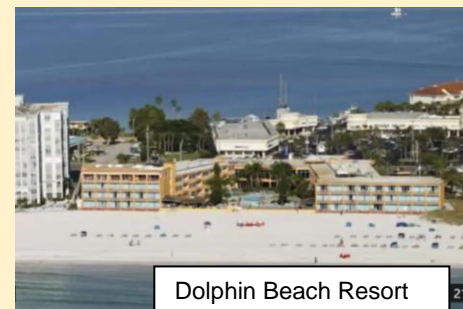

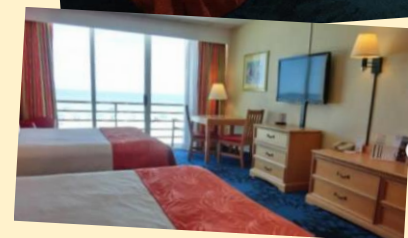

Tour of Dunedin: The Scottish-influenced Dunedin is St. Pete/Clearwater's fifth largest city and feels like a throwback to a simpler, more serene Florida. Here, the pace is relaxed - perfect for exploring the city's charming, quaint, picturesque, historical town with museums, boutiques, restaurants, clubs, cafes, and marina. We start off with a **humorous guided tour of historical Victoria Drive's** and hear about the spectacular homes on one of Dunedin's prettiest waterfront streets. History buffs will enjoy our visit to **Dunedin Historical Society & Museum**, located in a 1924 Atlantic Coast Line Railroad Station. Afterwards, those who appreciate the arts will enjoy the **Dunedin Fine Art Center** offering year-round exhibitions in four galleries featuring national, regional and local artists. A fabulous lunch for our fun group is included in this charming artistic town. **Fabulous setting for our included group lunch** – it's a surprise! Finally, enjoy free time at the **Dunedin Downtown Market**.

Tour of Sarasota: According to Travel.US News, the #1 "Best Places to Visit in Florida" is Sarasota! Hop aboard for an entertaining & informative **Sarasota Architectural Sightseeing Tour**. Visit outstanding examples of architecture and design: Mid-Century Modern, Art Deco, and Spanish Mediterranean Revival. Next, we'll enjoy a **special lunch together in a lovely, prime setting**. No visit to Sarasota is complete without visiting **St. Armands Circle** to explore its charms. For decades, St. Armands Circle has been known for elegant boutique shopping, gourmet restaurants and fine art galleries. Back in 1893, it was uninhabited land, farmed by homesteader Charles St. Armand. John Ringling bought the property in 1917 and developed homes, golf course and a circle of shops at the center. More than 30 Italian statues are located on the circle. Free time to shop, explore and enjoy!

Tour of Clearwater: Travel & Leisure named Clearwater Beach one of the top 25 beautiful beaches in the **WORLD!!!** Clearwater Beach is famous for its white sands and clear blue waters on the Gulf Coast. Both the beaches in Clearwater Beach and the sunset out at the pier make this part of Florida a must-see. **A step on guide will show us the sites** and share **the interesting historical facts** of this beautiful city. A visit to Clearwater must also include the **Clearwater Marine Aquarium**, celebrating 50 years - founded in 1972 and is a non-profit marine animal care and environmental education facility. It maintains marine exhibits for creatures such as dolphins, otters, sea turtles, sharks, stingrays, and starfish. The organization's activities also include animal assisted therapy and rescue and rehabilitation of injured marine animals. Injured dolphins and sea turtles are also rehabilitated at the Clearwater Marine Aquarium. If we are lucky, we even may see a rehabilitated creature returned to the ocean, but certainly their guides are friendly and knowledgeable. **A lovely group lunch** is included. After lunch, we will enjoy an exciting **dolphin sight-seeing tour**. The Gulf of Mexico is known for **wild dolphin sightings and pods**.

Tour of St. Petersburg: The city holds a Guinness World Record for the most consecutive days of sun, lasting 768 days. A fun day is in store: on our drive-by tour, our **step on guide** will regale us with fun facts as we **explore historic, Downtown St. Petersburg**. Next, located on the waterfront, **Dalí Museum** holds the largest collection of Salvador Dalí's works outside of Spain with ever changing exhibits. The building is just as impressive as the masterpieces displayed inside. Our **fabulous lunch as a group** must be at **Doc Ford's Rum Bar & Grille at St. Pete's Pier!** We will also visit the stunning **Imagine Museum Glass Art:** The glass Museum showcases major works of contemporary American and International art by founding and leading artists in the field of studio glass and art expression. 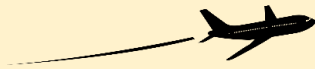
