Tuesday, August 25


At Sea After dinner enjoy the ship's lively entertainment.

Helsinki, Finland

Arrive 10:00 am Depart 6:00 pm

Helsinki has been the Finnish capital since 1812 when it was rebuilt by the Tsars of Russia along the lines of a miniature St. Petersburg. Today, the city is a pocket-sized international metropolis that retains a small-town feel. A hop-on, hop-off bus is available at the pier providing the perfect way for you to discover the charms of the city or take a shore excursion to nearby Porvoo, a charming medieval city founded nearly 800 years ago.



Thursday & Friday, August 27- 28 **St. Petersburg, Russia**

Arrive 7:00 am Depart 6:00 pm

We have two full days to explore this grand, iconic city! Founded by the Russian Tsar, Peter the Great, St. Petersburg has for centuries been the cultural center of Russia, with its spectacular architecture, Tchaikovsky operas and famous Kirov ballet. It has undergone many changes over the decades, but remains a dazzling destination, a Russian city with European flair filled with more than 200 museums, including the world famous Hermitage, and one of the largest English gardens in Europe!



Saturday, August 29

Tallinn, Estonia

Arrive 7:00 am Depart 4:00 pm

Tallinn is one of the most charming and captivating small European cities. Journey inside the ancient walls of Old Town to experience medieval buildings mixed with modern boutiques and delightful outdoor cafés. Visit the medieval landmarks of Toompea Castle and a 15th-century apothecary shop. Advance a couple of centuries to experience Tsar Peter I's Kadriorg Palace, filled with art and surrounded by sculpted gardens and peaceful woodlands.



Sunday, August 30

Stockholm, Sweden

Arrive 8:00 am Depart 4:00 pm

This port city is laced by an ingenious network of waterways and bridges strung between a freshwater lake and the sea. Stockholm is easily seen on foot or by waterway cruise. Its gabled old townhouses peer over cobblestone streets, while its magnificent 17th-century palace sits watching over the harbor. Here, you'll find galleries, museums and palaces to explore!
