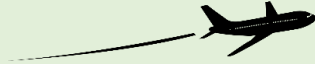

Day One: (D) Our direct non-stop flight takes us directly from O'Hare to Boston Logan airport. Upon our arrival, you will have a choice of discovering either the **John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum** or the **Edward M. Kennedy Institute for the United States Senate**. Dinner at a local favorite:

Day Two: (B) Being a baseball fan not required, there is something for everyone on this thrilling one hour guided walking tour of **Fenway Park-**

Back of the House Tour. Baseball lover or not, Fenway Park has stories to tell! Boston's legendary Fenway Park, America's Most Beloved Ballpark," is uniquely nestled in the city of Boston. See the home of Red Sox Legends, Williams, Yaz, Fisk and Rice. Visit Pesky's Pole and sit atop the world-famous Green Monster, which stands 37 feet 2 inches high overlooking left field. Next, enjoy an **Overview Tour of Boston** followed by the **Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum**. A Boston reporter wrote of Isabella Gardner: "Mrs. Jack Gardner is one of the seven wonders of Boston. There is nobody like her in any city in this country. She is a millionaire Bohemienne. Isabella devoted herself to her collection of paintings, sculptures, tapestries, furniture, manuscripts, rare books, & decorative arts. Hooray! Free time to peruse the area and enjoy lunch on your own in **Cambridge**. You will be amazed by **the MIT "Museum"** – enter a world dedicated to cutting-edge research, engineering, and innovation. An MIT education without the tests! Ever see a woman turn into a tiger? How about a chair exploding and reassembles itself? Maybe you've seen your own shadow freeze? It's the magic of innovation and it's only at MIT Museum. The MIT Museum, an interactive museum founded in 1971, explores the fascinating world of MIT—cutting-edge research, engineering, and innovation. You'll 'get educated' by a local guide who will take us through the museum and depending on when we visit, you might get a chance to try your hand at a little engineering yourself! We'll have time to discover the area on the way to dinner with our guide through Charlestown. Dinner will be on our own, and what a treat it will be. Just like all of the locals, we will enjoy a true "**seafood shack**" by the beach. Not a seafood fan, not to fret, this shack is known for its options, which are plentiful, and reasonable prices.

Day Three (B,D) – Today, our tour guide will share Boston's treasured **Trinity Church** in this one hour docent lead tour. Trinity Church is recognized for its National Historic Landmark building, considered by members of the American Association of Architects as one of this country's top 10 buildings. Then we are off to our **Tour of Boston Common and Beacon Hill** (with on and off privilege). Arrive at the **Paul Revere House**. Our experienced museum guide will lead our private group tour through the four rooms of the Revere House. We will take a leisurely 5-minute walk to the Paul Revere House and then on to **Old North Church** where we will hear a 15-minute introduction to this magnificent church before exploring on our own! Consider checking out the 4 Clough House on the campus where Chocolate is made in true colonial style and stop in and see a 'true to the time period' printing press, which is up and running. Enjoy your choice of traditional entrees at your Italian dinner in the **North End**. After dinner, go out on the town and get a little something just for you: For dessert, you will be provided \$5 to go out and get the dessert of your choosing: A Cannoli, Gelato, An Italian wedding cookie and an espresso, there are so many choices, you might buy 2! Back to the hotel



Day Four (B,D) – Today, we say goodbye to our hotel and take the **Olde Town Trolley** (a street trolley not the metro) as a group each individual in the group has 'hop on hop off privileges all day (until 5 PM). The trolley has a fully narrated tour of the city, which covers over 100 points of interest and encompasses

important historic sights and the major attractions, museums, and parks in Boston. It's your choice ...the trolley allows you to just sit for 2 hours for the whole tour or you can hop in and off all day. The trolley tour includes Boston's historic waterfront, the New England Aquarium, including the North End and the ride made famous by Paul Revere. You will see The U.S.S. Constitution and learn about the battle of Bunker Hill. Pass by the Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum, Quincy Market, Faneuil Hall, Government Center, the Old State House, and the New State House. The trolley passes through Beacon Hill, Copley Square, the Back Bay and Trinity Church. You will see the heart of the city—the Boston Common and the beautiful Public Garden, the Swan Boats, and the Make Way for Duckling statues. Afterwards, we depart for the Cape! A wonderful Dinner awaits us this evening as a group. We **STAY ON CAPE COD TONIGHT - CAPE DAZE** (days)!



Day Five (B,D)- A guided tour as we **Travel Olde King's Highway** dotted with historic Cape Cod architecture and New England Inns and we'll travel to the tip of the Cape. See famous lighthouses, historic Windmills, the giant dunes of Truro and the Pristine Province lands. Our Dune host will give us a one hour narrated sand dunes excursion giving us a glimpse into the pristine beaches and sand dunes that only four-wheel drive vehicles can access. It is quite an educational ride! Then we are off to **whale watching** - Discover the great whales of the North Atlantic during a three to four-hour Provincetown whale watching adventure. **Provincetown** is the closest port to access the **Stellwagen Bank National Marine Sanctuary**, a protected marine habitat with a diverse and incredible variety of aquatic life. A naturalist is with us and will share a unique perspective on the marine life we see this very day! Dinner is as a group in Provincetown, a town filled with activity at every turn and with many choices of where to dine.



Day Six (B,D) - Martha's Vineyard (B,D) - Depart with our local guide for a full day of touring, first by ferry, for the "Storybook Island" of Martha's Vineyard. From the Woods Hole Harbor Terminal. Your tour will include the famous **Gingerbread Houses, Island Tabernacle and Antique Carousel of Oak Bluffs**, stories and views of well-known resident's homes, time to **explore Edgartown** filled with its many shops, eateries, attractions and extraordinary views of the Atlantic. Your ferry departs Martha's Vineyard: This evening, we will enjoy a lobster Farewell dinner, which is included at a local favorite at the Hyannis Marina. Enjoy dinner at this classic Cape Cod location featuring both traditional New England seafood offerings as well as inspired old favorites, all while overlooking the beautiful harbor.

Day Seven (B) - Meet our museum guide this morning for our Pirate Museum tour, featured in the CNN film "This Explorer shares Shipwrecked Treasures with the World". Amazing! In 1984, underwater explorer Barry Clifford discovered a real sunken pirate ship. The pirate ship was the ship that sank off the coast of Cape Cod in 1717. For the past 30 years, Clifford and his team of divers, excavators and archeologists have continued unearthing the treasure trove, whose value is estimated at more than \$400 million. Unlike most treasure hunters, he does not sell what he finds. Talk directly to scientists to interpret x-rays of mysterious heavily encrusted objects and discover the painstaking and fascinating scientific work that preserves these time capsules of the past. 12:00 PM: Lunch at Faneuil Hall on own Depending upon your arrival and departure time, activities may be adjusted. Come Join us!
