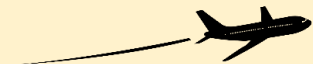


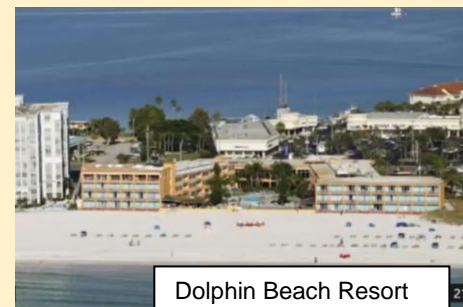

Tour of St. Petersburg: The city holds a Guinness World Record for the most consecutive days of sun, lasting 768 days. We have a fun day in store by exploring historic, Downtown St. Petersburg. First, we are off to **The Dalí Museum**. The waterfront Dalí Museum holds the largest collection of Salvador Dalí's works outside of Spain. The building is just as impressive as the masterpieces displayed inside. Next up, The **CHIHULY COLLECTION at the Morean Arts Center** is a permanent collection featuring 18 installations spanning several of the artist's most popular series including the *Ruby Red Icicle Chandelier*, and the *Mille Fiori*. The **New \$92 Million St. Pete Pier** made its official debut on July 6. There is much to enjoy and lots of space with 26 acres making up the Pier District. From world class public art, drinking/dining establishments with spectacular views, Adirondack chairs for relaxing, the Pier offers many exciting attractions including the Tampa Bay Watch Discovery Center, Cultural Grove, St. Petersburg Museum of History, and of course many shops. Trams are available from end to end. So much to choose on our free time. Save your appetites as we conclude this fabulous day with the **Starlight Sapphire Yacht - Dinner Cruise!**

Tour of Tampa: Tampa Bay History Museum (A Smithsonian Affiliate) Exhibits include coverage of the Tampa Bay area's first native inhabitants, Spanish conquistadors, and historical figures who shaped the area's history, as well as a reproduction of a 1920s cigar store. The Museum includes three floors of permanent and temporary exhibition galleries focusing on 12,000 years of Florida's history and heritage of the Tampa Bay area. The History Center is located along the scenic Tampa Riverwalk with time to explore. Feel like you are in Cuba during our fabulous group **Lunch at Columbia Café**, founded in 1905 by Cuban immigrant Casimiro Hernandez Sr. After lunch, we'll visit the heart of **Tampa's Historic District, Ybor City** which is one of only three National Historic Landmark Districts located in Florida and became "the cigar capital of the world" by 1900. Explore the **Ybor City Visitor Center's** small museum and watch a video presentation to provide some background to this city's colorful history. Then we're off to a fascinating guided tour with top to bottom exploration of **El Reloj**, the only cigar factory still in operation in Cigar City, (Tampa, FL). This interesting tour takes us through the process of cigar making both by hand and on antique cigar machines, the Newman family legacy, the history of Cigar City, and more. This historic cigar factory tour will please cigar enthusiasts and history buffs alike.

Tour of Tarpon Springs: The historic and beautiful riverfront town of Tarpon Springs with its Greek heritage must be seen to be believed. It is the Sponge Capital of the World and it helped build a Greek Community now famous not only for the world's finest sponges but for some of the places we will be visiting today. Hear about the sponge industry and local Greek culture; **Taste of Greece** with Greek wine, coffee, meat and bakery tastings; **Downtown Historic District Tour** including **St. Nicholas** church, **Depot Museum**, **Famous Historic Tarpon Springs Sponge Docks Tour**; see and learn about the Sponge boats at the working sponge docks; Enjoy **group lunch at authentic Greek Restaurant**; **Sponge Diving exhibition** boat ride with free time to shop the markets on Dodecanese Boulevard for unique Greek Souvenirs. Opa!

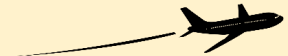
Tour of Sarasota: According to Travel.US News, the #1 "Best Places to Visit in Florida" is Sarasota! No visit to Sarasota is complete without visiting John & Mable **Ringling Museum of Art** where we'll tour the magnificent **Ca' d'Zan Mansion** and **extensive gardens**. Then we hop aboard our entertaining & informative **Sarasota City Sightseeing Tour**. Our last stop of the day, explore the charms of **St. Armands Circle**. For decades, St. Armands Circle has been known for elegant boutique shopping, gourmet restaurants and fine art galleries. Back in 1893, it was uninhabited land, farmed by homesteader Charles St. Armand. John Ringling bought the property in 1917 and developed homes, golf course and a circle of shops at the center.
